GEOGRAPHERS BIOBIBLIOGRAPHICAL STUDIES (GBS), is an annual serial international publication devoted to the critical biographical assessment of scholars' contributions to geography and geographical knowledge. It was first published in 1977. From 2006, **GBS** has been co-edited by Charles W J Withers (University of Edinburgh) and Hayden Lorimer (University of Glasgow) on behalf of the International Geographical Union Commission on the History of Geography (previously the Commission on the History of Geographical Thought) and the International Union of the History and Philosophy of Science. ***Geographers Biobibliographical Studies*** is published by the Continuum International Publishing Group with the assistance of the Executive Committee of the International Geographical Union.

Each volume of ***Geographers Biobibliographical Studies*** is devoted to essays offering biographical assessment of scholars' contributions to geography and geographical knowledge, often but not exclusively under the headings of 'Education, Life and Work', 'Scientific Ideas and Geographical Thought', and 'Influence and Spread of Ideas'.

At a time of widespread and critical interdisciplinary engagement in biography and in biographical writing as a scholarly genre, ***Geographers Biobibliographical Studies*** is the only publication devoted to the assessment of scholars' contributions to geography and to geographical knowledge in an international context. Each volume normally contains 9-10 biographical essays illustrated (where possible) with a portrait photograph.

Since Volume 1 in 1977, over 420 biographical essays of geographers and persons who have contributed to geography and geographical knowledge have been published – from Al-Biruni (Abu'Rayhan Muhammad) (973-1054), to Isaiah Bowman (1878-1950), Charles Darwin (1809-1882), Ferdinand Magellan (c.1480-1521), Marco Polo (1254-1324), Carl Ortwin Sauer (1889-1975), Paul Vidal de la Blache (1845-1917) and John Kirtland Wright (1891-1975), to name only a few. Contributions to *Geographers Biobibliographical Studies*

Contributions to ***Geographers Biobibliographical Studies*** are welcome. Intending contributors should contact either of the co-editors in the first instance (for full contact details, see below). Essays, normally to a maximum of 12,000 words, should be in English. Essays in **GBS** should

- provide a fitting written memorial of geographers' achievements in advancing geographical knowledge and understanding, however and wherever defined
- convey the significance of an individual's work and their contribution to geography and geographical knowledge.

Geographers Biobibliographical Studies is always interested in extending its coverage via essays that, for example, address:

- the collective biography, or prosopography, of a group of individuals, a particular institutional setting or ‘school’ of geographical activity
- women’s contributions to geography and geographical knowledge
- the contribution to geography and to geographical knowledge of ‘non-geographers’ (e.g., map makers and cartographers, explorers, travellers and missionaries)
- the under-representation of geographers from outwith the Anglo-American geographical world
- contributions to the teaching of geography
- contributions of physical geographers and earth scientists
