Dear participants,

the program of our congress and field trip is now ready to publish. Thank you very much for the submission of highly interesting papers, and of course for your registrations, too.

As you can see in the schedule we have five sessions with twenty papers in total; the last session will take place at the Research Library in Gotha.

Please keep in mind that the paper presentation should not exceed 20 minutes. Standard technical equipment and internet connections are certainly available at the Leibniz Institute for Regional Geography and at the Research Library Gotha, too.

The accommodations are already booked and the team of the Leibniz Institute for Regional Geography is actually very busy in preparing the details for the field trip from Leipzig to Cologne. We all look forward to have a very interesting and also comfortable summer week in Germany.

Some helpful information:

The congress hotel in Leipzig is the **Grand City Hotel Leipzig Zentrum**, Gerichtsweg 12, Tel.: +49 (0)30 97 80 88 88; www.grandcity-hotel-leipzig-zentrum.de/en

The Grand City Hotel Leipzig Zentrum is situated in a quiet side road in the centre of Leipzig only about 1.000 meters away from the Opera and the Gewandhaus between Dresdner and Prager Straße.

Arriving by car:

From the A14 motorway, take the Leipzig Mitte exit and drive past the "Neuen Messe" trade fair centre. Follow the signs to the B2 towards Gera/Chemnitz. Cross the steel bridge and continue on "Brandenburger Strasse". After around 1.5 km you reach Gerichtsweg. The Grand City Hotel Leipzig Zentrum is on the right.

Arriving by train:

From the central station, take the number 4 tram towards "Stötteritz" or the number 7 tram towards "Sommerfeld". Get off at the third stop, "Gerichtsweg" the Grand City Hotel Leipzig Zentrum is on the right-hand side of the street.

We made the reservations according to your registration. The hotel is located in the middle between the city centre and the Leibniz Institute for Regional Geography.

The congress starts at our institute on Tuesday, August 21 with a first reception at 1 p.m.

The Institute is located at the eastern edge of Leipzig and can be reached

- from central railway station by tram: Tram 3 or 7 to Sommerfeld terminus (journey ca. 45 min., then ca. 15 min. on foot)
- from central railway station by tram and bus: Tram 7 towards Sommerfeld as far as Barbarastraße, change to bus route 90 as far as Schongauerstrasse (journey ca. 30 min., then ca. 5 min. on foot)
- from central railway station by local train: S11 or Regionalbahn/Regionalexpress towards Wurzen as far as Engelsdorf (journey ca. 10 min., then ca. 15 min. on foot)
- by car: via A14, exit Leipzig-Ost, free parking at the Paunsdorf-Center

For those who participate in the field trip:

We travel to Gotha by rail on the morning of Thursday, August 23; the rail ride will take around two hours. Our hotel is the **Waldbahnhotel Gotha**, Bahnhofstrasse 16, 99867 Gotha, Tel.: + 49 (0)3621 2340; http://waldbahn-hotel.de, vis-à-vis Gotha central station and a little walk away from the Friedenstein Castle, where the Research Library is located.

The following day we take the bus. After the visit of the famous Wartburg Castle and a break at Eisenach city we want to reach our romantic destination Assmannshausen (Rhine Gorge) in the late afternoon. The accommodation for two days is the **Hotel Altes Haus Assmannshausen**, Lorcher Strasse 8, 65385 Assmannshausen, Tel.: + 49 (0)6722 40350; www.hotel-altes-haus.info/englisch/

Our field trip ends on Sunday, August 26 with a two hour rail ride to Cologne. We want to arrive at Cologne central station about noon, so that you have enough time to reach your hotel easily. The official opening of the IGC in the Cologne Philharmonic is at 3 p.m.
